Style of Instruction

The program will begin on Tuesday October 6 with a Virtual Message from our Pastor Father Thomas Walsh. At the present time our parish will be Home Schooled with a weekly Virtual Message from our Pastoral Staff. Books will be ordered for your child and supplemental materials will be emailed to the families. The tentative date for Book Distribution will be October 3 and 4 after Masses.

Once the restrictions ease up, hopefully by January, it is our intent to bring the students back into the classroom. We have a vibrant School Community that uses the facilities all day. For the safety of all our parish children and volunteers we need to be sure the premises is safe and sanitized. At this point our program will be Virtual/Home Study.

Meetings in the Church will be planned for our Sacramental Preparation Students. Grades 1, 2 and 8.

Information and Reminders

All families enrolled in our program must be registered Parishioners. To register with the parish you must come into the Parish Office to file the appropriate application. It is your obligation as a parishioner to attend Mass and support the parish.

New students and new 1st graders in the program must provide a Baptismal certificate if baptized in a church other than St. Bartholomew.

Families transferring to our parish must release themselves from their existing parish and provide us with Sacramental records and a transfer of Religious Education permanent records.

For Students preparing for the reception of a sacrament, it is a two year commitment of religious education followed by formation and preparation. This is a diocesan policy.
